Paintings are human expressions of the world they see. We all look out from a unique

perspective. Artists attempt to capture the essential structure and radience of their subjects. Until now, their tools were pigment on paper, wood or canvas and the process was often lengthy. With the advent of the computer, the process changed radically. Entirely new styles evolved. However, one program, "Painter", was developed to simulate traditional pigment offering Oil, Chalk or Watercolour to name a few of the mediums and bristle or smooth, fine or coarse brushes. With this program came the elimination of drying time for the pigment and instant "undo" to step backward without starting over.

price most people can afford making the artist available to not only the wealthy. "Quick Paintings" are the most economical painting. They are fast "oil" sketches and printed to an archival rag paper with a torn or "deckled" edge approximately 5 x 7 inches in size.

The process is simple. Call or email Cindy Bennett to book an appointment. You will bring or have emailed a digital photo of the subject of the portrait. If you are the subject, as in the case of live

events, you will take your own photo using the camera on the computer. Use as many shots as you like.

Once the painting is created and printed on a giclee printer with archival pigment, it is ready to hang - often the next day! More elegant framing can be requested.
